Our Vision

Why East Timor?

- East Timor (Timor-Leste) was an ally of Australia losing 40,000 of its people in WW2, fighting with the diggers against the Japanese
- Located only 600 km from Australia's coastline, approximately 46% of East Timor's population have never had any schooling
- The illiteracy levels are appalling, approximately 60% women and 44% men
- The population is just over 1,000,000 people with over 50% under 21 years old
- International experience shows that improving levels of education in emerging societies drives economic prosperity
- East Timor is not presently equipped to educate its young children to international standards

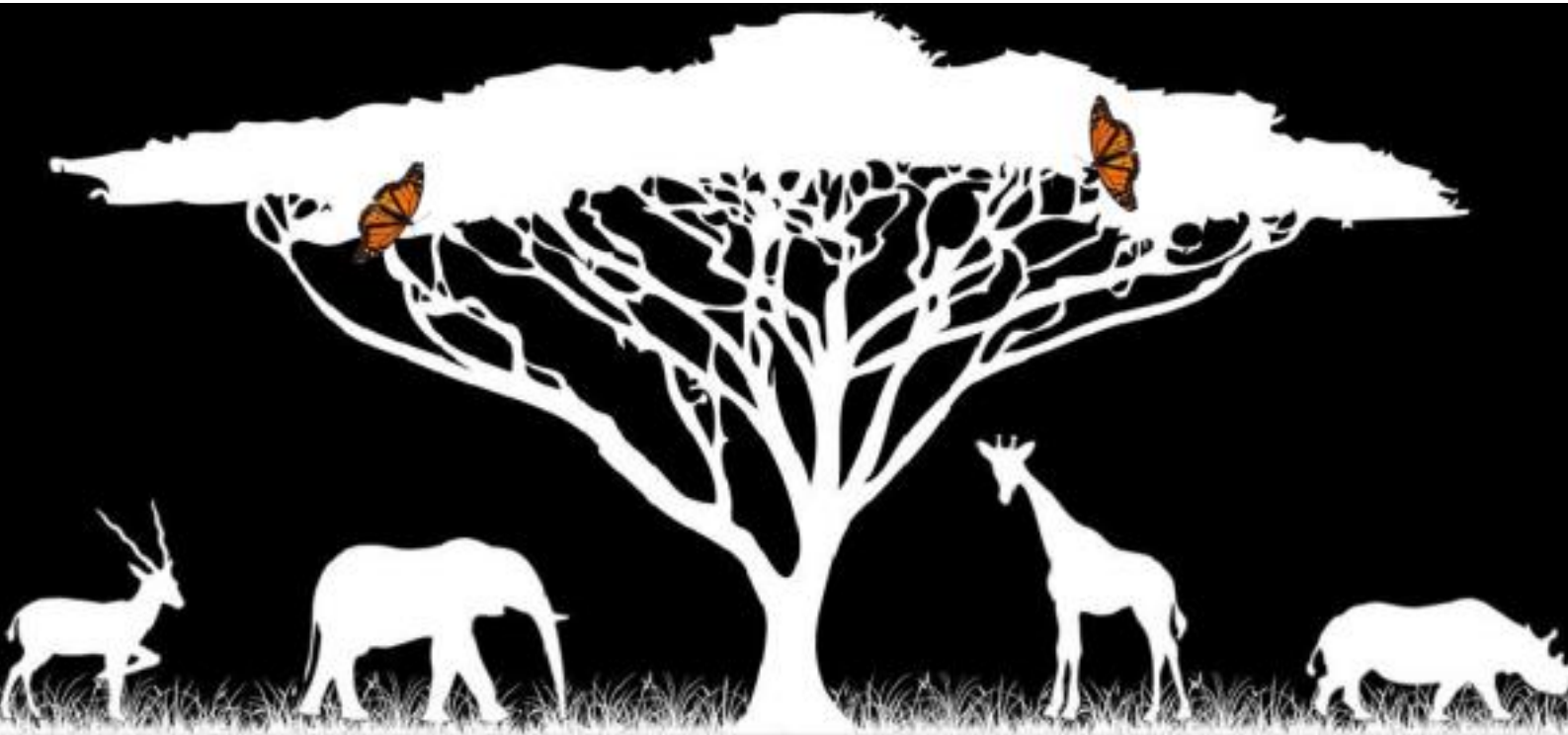
ICFP Baucau College
